



Euromeduc: Call for the candidature of experts for the media literacy seminars and Congress

Hello,

You have recently been informed of the launch of the [Euromeduc](#) project, which organises a European congress on media literacy in 2009. Three thematic seminars prepare the congress.

The seminars will be prepared and animated by four experts in the fields under discussion. A remuneration of 1000 euros is foreseen, as well as the transportation and accommodation costs for the seminar and the Congress. The themes of the three seminars are as follows:

- *Media production by young people and media literacy* (Paris, 30 June – 2 July 2008)
- *Lifelong Media Learning : innovative practices outside school* (Brussels, 17-19 November 2008)
- *Media literacy and appropriation of Internet by young people* (Faro, 16-19 February 2009)

In addition, an expert in charge of the evaluation process of [Euromeduc](#) project is also needed.

A remuneration of 2500 euros is foreseen, as well as the transportation and accommodation costs for the three seminar and the Congress. Evaluator have to provide a suitable evaluation methodology, will participate to the three seminars and the congress and provide an evaluation report after each event .
